Internet Access and Setup

Internet access is important as it allows your child to share work with their teacher, classmates, families, do research, and more. Our clean filtered internet enables safe access to approved content when students are connected to school wi-fi.

Connection fees are 25KD per year. Homeroom teachers will assist students with connecting to the wi-fi once payment has been made. Seesaw is the main app for learning journals and communicating student learning home.
